THOUGHT FOR THE WEEK

" Paul said $^{\text{Col 2:16-17}}$ that Jewish festivals and celebrations were actually a shadow of the things to come through Christ. And though as Christians we may not commemorate these holidays in the traditional biblical sense, as we discover the significance of each, we will certainly gain a greater knowledge of God's Word, an improved understanding of the Bible, and a deeper relationship with the Lord.

The observance of the Feast of Trumpets is recorded in the Old Testament $^{\text{Lev 23:23-25, Num 29:1-6}}$. The Feast of Trumpets begins with Rosh Hashanah. The solemnizations continue for Ten Days of Repentance, culminating on Yom Kippur or the Day of Atonement.

Rosh Hashanah or Jewish New Year is called the Feast of Trumpets in the Bible because it begins the Jewish High Holy Days and Ten Days of Repentance with the blowing of the ram's horn, the shofar, calling God's people together to repent from their sins.

Rosh Hashanah is also known as the Day of Judgment. At the Final Judgment Rev 20:15, we read that "anyone whose name was not found recorded in the Book of Life was thrown into the lake of fire," this Book of Life as belonging to the Lamb, Jesus Christ Rev 21:27

The New Year of the Jewish calendar begins on Rosh Hashanah (September or October). An easy way to calculate the Jewish calendar year is to add 3761 to the Gregorian calendar year. The Jewish calendar is based on both solar and lunar movements. Since the Jewish day begins and ends at sunset, the holidays begin at sundown on the evening of the previous day. Rosh Hashanah is also the start of the civil year in Israel. It is a solemn day of soul-searching, forgiveness, repentance and remembering God's judgment, as well as a joyful day of celebration, looking forward to God's goodness and mercy in the New Year."
