**THOUGHT FOR THE WEEK**  
*“Rebellion is as bad as the sin of witchcraft, and stubbornness is as bad as worshipping idols,” 1 Samuel 15:23*  
“Why would God compare these issues to sins as serious as worshipping idols or practicing witchcraft? Perhaps because rebellion involves turning away from God and demanding to do things our way. Witchcraft includes the same: making things come out according to our desires rather than trusting God. Either one is a refusal to trust. When stubbornness involves refusing to let go of things we need to relinquish, those things are more important to us than God. God wants to be the focus of our heart and resents anything else in His place.  
Hosea 7:13-14 says, *“Woe to them, because they have strayed from me! Destruction to them, because they have rebelled against me! I long to redeem them but they speak lies against me. They do not cry out to me from their hearts but wail upon their beds.”*

Nor is idolatry easy to relinquish once we’ve recognized it. Following Jesus runs counter to everything we’d normally choose to do, especially those of us who have experienced being hurt. But God loves us too much to leave us where we are. He is merciful, working only as much as we can stand, yet continually calling us closer to Him.”  
As you spend time with the Lord asking Him about these things, write down the issues He begins bringing to mind. You may find that each one opens up into a whole set of subjects you need to deal with. Piece by piece He will work in you.  
*Lord, the change may be beginning to come. Thank You that you’re patient with us, even though You abhor this sin. Thank You for the fact that You keep loving and encouraging us even as we refuse to change. Continue to give us Your strength for the journey.*
